#### Cattle News from Producers:

Within the last month or two we've sold several bigger consignments of bred 2 year olds and young to solid mouth bred cows. Most of those were medium to heavy bred and ranged from \$1900-\$2850 per head. News traveled fast once we announced the consignments and numerous individuals participated in bidding on and buying of those females. Early advertising (print, radio, tv program, and our website) as well as calls and texts to potential buyers definitely had a positive effect on sale day. Keep that in mind next time you have replacement females, breeding bulls etc. that need recognition prior to sale day.

It's October and the seasonal trend for a lower calf market prevails once again. Most medium to heavier weight calves are now trading at \$15-\$20 cwt. lower than late summer, but historically are still bringing lots of dollars per head. Calf buyers (and their crew) have a busy and demanding schedule for the next 60-75 days with fall purchases of mostly unweaned calves. Hopefully by late November the health conditions of these calves will improve, and we'll rebound back to higher price levels.

I have been surprised at the better than average condition most lambs and kids have been in considering the dry range conditions in most areas.

It is evident that producers are getting through predation issues in many ways such as wildlife services, snares, traps, independent trappers, trapping clubs, and of course guardian dogs. It is my opinion we all must continue to do what we can to protect our industry by supporting wildlife services and other means.

One thing to always remember is that we are here to receive livestock 24/7! Weekends are important to those who can't get away on week days, and lots of our customers take advantage of that time.

We always appreciate calls on your consignments allowing us to better market your livestock.
